

FIRE IN SHEFFIELD

Shortly before ten o'clock Wednesday night, a fire was discovered in a room which is used as a workshop, in connection with the shop of Mr. Alfred Platts, tailor, Meadow-street. A messenger was sent to the Fire Office, but before Superintendent Pound and his brigade, had time to arrive on the spot the fire had been extinguished the use of water-buckets. The building which belongs to Mr. Armitage was but slightly damaged. About £12 or £14 worth of cloth remnants and patterns constituted the loss by fire.
