Street Tragedy Aged Sheffield Man's Collapse and Death

Consternation was caused in High Street, Sheffield, shortly before nine o'clock this morning, by the collapse of an elderly gentleman who was taken ill while travelling to the city on a tramcar from Nether Edge.

After alighting in High Street, he was seen to fall down. Assistance was quickly forthcoming, and the Fire Brigade Ambulance was summoned, but the man expired quickly, and was taken to the Sheffield Public Mortuary.

Later in the day his identity was established as that of John Hopkins Pollard of 145 Cemetery Road.
